### **Speaker's Bureau**

Share your enthusiasm about the Park's natural, cultural, and historical resources and the importance of protecting them.



### **Volunteer Trail Patrol**

Do you like to hike, mountain bike, or ride your horse through unique and beautiful open spaces? The Park's volunteer Patrol Members monitor trails, report incidents and emergencies, share park policies with visitors, and provide general park information to the public. Volunteers are required to patrol in pairs and are asked to enjoy at least one, four hour patrol per month for a minimum of one year.

### **River Valley Guides (Trail Docents)**

Are you an enthusiastic, dedicated, friendly and like to teach others while enjoying the outdoors? We want you to lead hikes for the River Park! Upon acceptance, you will be thoroughly trained about the River Park in a specially designed course exploring plants, animals, the art and science of interpretation and other relevant topics.

### **Sikes Adobe Historic Farmstead Docents**

Become a Sikes Docent and discover the fascinating architectural and family history of the farmstead and Sikes family, as well as the local agricultural history of the late 1800's. You will also learn tips and techniques for being a docent, and discuss theories of interpretation. Docents help convey the pioneer farm experience in Southern California to the public using the Sikes Adobe Farmstead as the stage.

## Eagle Scout Projects



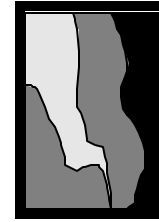

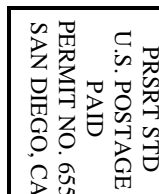

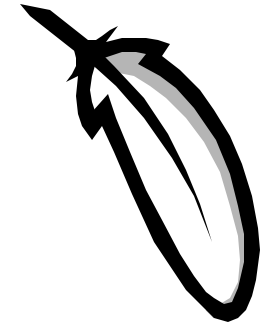
