The primary purpose of today's site visit is to learn the purpose and function of the Water Quality Treatment Ponds that the San Dieguito River Park is constructing adjacent to the Southern California Edison Wetland Restoration Project. A speaker, Mark Carpenter, with KTU+A Landscape Architecture, will be present to explain how the design and construction of the treatment ponds will enable the ponds to clean urban runoff before it is introduced into the newly created tidal wetlands.

After the presentation at the treatment ponds (which are located just behind the Albertson's Shopping Center), those who are interested are invited to walk the lagoon trail from the ponds as it parallels the freeway and then crosses a bridge and goes under the freeway, and then crosses a second bridge on the west side of the freeway. From there, those who are interested are invited to continue on to the boardwalk. The distance is approximately 1.5 miles one way.

Please come prepared for standing and walking. Wear comfortable shoes and bring a bottle of water.
