This is an adobe outbuilding, replicated through the records from initial 2002 restoration efforts at the Sikes Adobe. The building dates to ca. 1885-1890. Once used as a dairy house, it will be the subject of ongoing research and interpretation. Like the farmhouse, the Creamery will be open to the public as part of the tour experience; and serve as an additional opportunity to tell the Sikes' family story within the context of San Diego's pioneer farming history.

The Creamery building has been an on-going project of the San Dieguito River Park JPA at the Sikes Adobe. Though interrupted by the 2007 Witch Creek fire, we are now in the final weeks of its completion and preparation. This has been a community project, with help from volunteers including the Bricklayers of San Diego & Imperial Counties Apprenticeship Trust and the New Haven School's Youth Build Program.
